REQUIREMENTS

A completed ERAS application will be comprised of:

- Curriculum vitae
- Official medical school transcripts
- USMLE Step 1 and Step 2/COMLEX Level 1 and 2 score reports
- Three letters of recommendation (one of which must be from the chair of medicine or internal medicine program director)
- Dean's letter (Medical Student Performance Evaluation)
- Personal statement

Please note: Foreign medical school graduates must be ECFMG-certified and have significant U.S. clinical experience at the time of application.
